

If the baby bird is injured or you are unable to put it back in its nest:

Place the baby in a loosely covered container (so it can breathe) with a soft blanket or towel (loop-free, so its toes or limbs don't get caught.)

Keep in a warm, quiet, dark place until you can get it to a rehabber.
